Laboratory Operations

We are working hard to ensure our move has minimal impact on project timelines by continuing to work on all projects during the move period. Client samples currently in our lab will be moved by an insured mover or returned prior to the move. Our test equipment is scheduled for calibration immediately upon occupancy. Calibrations are performed on our equipment in two cycles annually and we have duplicates of equipment so testing will not be affected by this calibration cycle.

Quality Management

This move only involves the physical location of our facility. All existing ISO 17025:2017 Quality Management System documents and processes currently approved will be re-located to the new facility, intact. We have coordinated this move with our Accreditation Registrar to ensure that our system will remain approved to ISO 17025:2017 after the relocation. Additionally, we are working within the directives of the IECCE CB Scheme and our Third-Party Test Lab programs for relocation assessments. Once our relocation assessments are complete, we will post new certificates to our website as they are available.
